**Should Virginia use federal funding to expand Medicaid to bridge the gap between the current Medicaid program and qualifying for marketplace subsidies?**

Yes - Virginia has lost millions of dollars by refusing to expand Medicaid and demand coverage to 100,000 working Virginians at the same time.

**Should Virginia provide health care coverage for those under 18, regardless of immigration status?**

Yes - This is a politically complex policy to institute without (original: w/o) Medicaid expansion.

**Do you support state and/or local law enforcement agencies volunteer to become deputized ICE agents and enforce civil immigration laws by signing a 287(g) agreement?**

No - State and local law enforcement must maintain independence from the federal government (original: gov't).

**Should all age-eligible individuals who pass the driving exam be allowed a driver's license, regardless of immigration status?**

Yes - I have worked to implement this policy for many years (see my voting record). Trump's election make this an impossibility.

**Do you support policies that protect cooperating victims of crime and witnesses from routine immigration inquiries by law enforcement?**

Yes - We must do all we can to build trust between law enforcement and our immigrant communities.

**Should the minimum wage be raised to \$15 in Virginia?**

Yes - Opposition to raising our minimum wage is partisan; changing the political composition of our General Assembly is the only way to increase Virginia's minimum wage.

**Should Virginia rescind its "right to work" law?**

Yes - Workers should be allowed to unionize - not forced to unionize or prohibited from unionizing.

**Should the state establish a new top tax rate bracket (current top bracket is \$17,000) and update our current brackets to account for inflation?**

Yes - Again, the current General Assembly lacks the political will to make these tax changes.

**Should Virginia protect/expand funding for programs that benefit English Language Learners?**

Yes - This is an important investment in our economy. I have worked to protect + support English Language Learners (original: ELL's) for many years.

**Should college in-state tuition rates be available to any student who graduates from a Virginia high school, regardless of immigration status?**

Yes - With (original: W/) certain qualification; ex: DACA students screening methodology.

**What strategies do you support to expand college affordability?**

Regulation of education loan collectors; more state funding in shared financial incentives for students to graduate in 4 years.

**What steps would you take to improve language access of state documents and agencies to English Language Learners?**

Require translations to be made available according to the regulations concerning ballot translations.

**Do you support no excuse absentee voting?**

Yes - I have filed legislation which would increase voter access & encourage voting during every term that I have served as a delegate.
